Pentecost is about Christ's Indwelling through the Holy Spirit: the REPLICATION OF THE INCARNATION.

Kingdomtide is about Christ's Great Commission: the EXPANSION OF THE INCARNATION.

The first part of Advent is about Christ's Second Coming: the UNIVERSAL DOMINION OF THE INCARNATION.
